





When asked, many sommeliers and wine collectors say that Bourgogne (Burgundy) is their favorite wine to drink. Bourgogne balances power and finesse like few other wines in the world can. The region is made up of small, family-run vineyards that have been passed down from generation to generation, crafting wines that reflect their passion and dedication. While Chardonnay and Pinot Noir are two of the most popular wine varietals in the US, many wine drinkers never experience the crisp, mineral, fruit-forward wines from the region that inspired California and Oregon winemakers to plant grapes in the first place.

Join us, with our very own Peter Granoff MS as he presents a flight of wines from this prestigious winegrowing region of France. We look forward to exploring the nuances of a spectacular flight of wines that speak of this distinct and majestic place and tell the stories of where they were grown.



In his 40+ years in the wine business, Master Sommelier Peter Granoff has worn lots of hats. From schlepping boxes and bussing tables to receiving the 1991 “Sommelier of the Year” award from the James Beard Foundation and launching Virtual Vineyards (1995, the first U.S. entity to sell wine on the internet), Peter has traveled the world to immerse himself in almost all facets of the wine industry.

He just recently completed a second term serving on the Master Sommeliers Board of Directors. His goofy sense of humor and unconventional approach to the business of wine bring a refreshing change of pace to San Francisco's wine shops. He has been an adjunct member of the faculty at the Culinary Institute of America's Professional Wine Studies program, and is internationally known as a speaker, wine educator, wine competition judge, and provider of free wine insulting.
