*Jeff Mangahas is the Vice President and Director of Winemaking at Williams Selyem, where he has helped shape the estate's elegant, site-driven style since joining in 2011. A Washington State native and University of Washington graduate with a background in cellular and molecular biology, he began his career as a research scientist before following his curiosity about wine to UC Davis, where he earned a master's degree in enology. After early winemaking roles at Artesa, Dutton-Goldfield, and Hartford Family Winery, Jeff brought a deep love of Pinot Noir, a scientific approach, and a hands-on sensibility to Williams Selyem, where he continues to craft wines that reflect both precision and place.*
