

BLIND TASTING GAME NIGHT Flavor vs. Structure WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 16, 2024 • 4PM - 7PM




Much that is written about wine for consumers, especially in the American wine press, places heavy emphasis on lyrical, and sometimes fanciful, aroma and flavor descriptors.

If you have ever stuck a toe in the waters plied by the multi-level Master Sommelier, Master of Wine or WSET programs, however, you know that flavor and aroma descriptors get a good deal less emphasis than understanding a wine's basic structure. In addition, flavors and aromas are easily the most subjective aspects of the way we enjoy and experience wine, and are therefore the most difficult terrains on which to establish common ground.

Structure in wine, on the other hand, is the most fundamental aspect of wine appreciation and understanding—and is, at the same time, the easiest set of variables on which establish a shared experience.

For this Flight Night, we will pour 5 wines blind and Master Sommelier Peter Granoff will use them to help you explore structure. You will get a list of the wines before leaving, but their identities will be secondary. The goal isn't to guess what they are either, as they have been chosen simply to illustrate the theme of the blind tasting. Join Us!
