The history of Australian wine is inextricably intertwined with the Hill-Smiths, who have been planting vineyards and crafting quality wine for over 175 years and across six generations. Starting with Samuel Smith planting vines under moonlight during the 1840s in Angaston, South Australia, the Hill-Smith Family Estates have evolved from Australia's oldest family owned winery at Yalumba. to a wide-ranging family of wineries throughout Oceana: Jansz and Dalrymple in Tasmania, Pewsey Vale Vineyard in Eden Valley, and Nautilus Estate in Marlborough, New Zealand.

Through the guidance of the Yalumba Nursery in the Barossa Valley, the Family has developed vineyard sites in many of the best regions on the continent—including Barossa, Limestone Coast, Riverland, Tasmania and Marlborough. The winery at Yalumba also features its own cooperage and Master Cooper, making Yalumba the only winery in the Southern Hemisphere to feature both a cooperage and a vine nursery.

Not only is the Hill-Smith Family dedicated to crafting fine wine, but their distribution and import companies—Samuel Smith & Son and Negociants—represent some of the most revered family-owned wineries from the Southern Hemisphere, distributing wine for well over 100 years.

From its very first vintage in 1849, to the multi-faceted wine company Hill-Smith Family Estates has become, the Hill-Smiths pride themselves on their family heritage and their connection to people; and above all the burning desire to remain a sustainable and successful family-owned wine business for generations to come.

Come taste some of their finest and most unique wines from the continent—including the 'Tri-Centenary' Grenache that helped create the Barossa's Old Vine Charter. Chris Spangler, the US Market Manager, will be on hand to greet you and spin his best yarn about the family's 175-year history.
