2024 RA RA WINE CO. ROSÉ OF GRENACHE DRY CREEK VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

Founded in 2018 Kara Marie Wines was established by Kara Groom, who was trained and mentored by her winemaker father, Daryl Groom (whose wines we are proud to have previously featured in our wine club). After spending years 'hemisphere hopping' working multiple wine harvests, it was time to come home to Sonoma County. Upon her return, Kara began making wine under her own label. Crafted in a lively, fruit forward style, her Ra Ra Wine Co. wines are made with a low-intervention mindset with no oak influence—allowing the fruit to shine. In addition to Melon de Bourgogne, Kara also produces a dry Riesling, Rosé of Grenache, and a Pinot Noir Nouveau. She also produces a series of skin contact white wines and carbonic fermentations under her Little Ra Ra Ferments label.

100% Grenache sourced from the heart of Dry Creek Valley, grown by the Saini family. As fifth generation farmers, their passion for quality, coupled with their experience and familiarity with the land they farm, sets their fruit apart. The grapes were soaked on their skins to imbue a beautiful light pink hue, followed by a gentle whole cluster press. The juice was then fermented for two weeks at cool temperatures. After fermentation, the wine was stored in stainless steel until bottling to maintain the fresh and bright fruit aromas. Pale powder-pink in color, with a bouquet of fresh red berries and citrus zest. The palate exhibits flavors of white peach, strawberry and watermelon. Lightly textured with juicy acidity that makes it the perfect summer quencher.

2024 SEGNO LIBRANDI *CIRÒ* ROSATO CALABRIA, ITALY

The Librandi winery was founded in 1950 by Antonio and Nicodemo Librandi, in Cirò Marina, a small town in the southern Italian region of Calabria (Italy's boot tip), on the splendid Ionian coastline. Since 2012, the winery has been run by Nicodemo, his two sons Paolo and Raffaele, his nephew Francesco and his niece Teresa. To this day, they remain faithful to the principles that inspired their forefathers by preserving and promoting Calabrian wine heritage, particularly its indigenous grape varieties. Today, Librandi owns a total of 890 acres, 573 of which are vineyards, 247 are olive groves and the remainder maintained as forest. A champion of local grape varieties, the vineyards are planted primarily with the local varietals: Gaglioppo, Magliocco and Mantonico, along with some international varietals as well. All the Librandi wines and olive oils are made exclusively from estate-grown grapes and olives.

The epitome of Cirò Rosato, this wine is the interpretation and summary of the work of three generations, four estates, a deep knowledge of the area and years of collaboration. 100% Gaglioppo, processed entirely in stainless steel and aged in bottle prior to release. Remarkable bright copper hue. Complex, heady aromas of red summer fruits layered with savory herbs and dried floral notes. The palate offers fleshy flavors of pomegranate, strawberry, red plum, blood orange and a touch potpourri. Wonderfully textured, with ample acid through the lengthy finish. Exceptional.
